#### 4. 2024 Planning

There is a solar eclipse that will happen right over Indiana on April 8, 2024 – there is some fear there will be a shortage of hotels at that time, so keep this in mind as we plan dates for next year's State Meet.

- Lifeguards are needed for the Olympic Trials. USA Nationals at the IUPUI Natatorium this summer will also need volunteers. Lisa Brown has info.
- During Covid we dropped from 34 teams down to 20 when we didn't automatically sign clubs up and pay their registration fees. Total membership numbers are good, but some clubs have dissolved. We have 99 unattached swimmers, so we should pay attention to numbers next year and be thinking of what we can do to help teams start up again.
